# Dealing with Domestic Violence

This leaflet explains what Cosmopolitan Housing Association can do to tackle domestic violence.

If you have any questions we will be pleased to discuss them with you.

## Policy Statement

Cosmopolitan Housing Association believes that no tenant should live in fear of violence from a spouse or partner, former spouse or partner or other member of their household, and will assist and support any person suffering from or threatened with violence.

If you contact Cosmopolitan Housing Association, you can be confident that you will be treated equally and with sensitivity regardless of your age, disability, gender, sexual orientation, ethnicity, religion or beliefs.

## What is domestic violence?

Domestic violence may be physical, emotional, sexual, psychological and economic abuse. It is most often carried out by men, but may also be by women and between gay and lesbian as well as heterosexual partners.

Domestic violence is a criminal offence. If you are a victim, it is **NOT** your fault.

## Reporting Domestic violence

If you are suffering from domestic violence – don't suffer in silence. You can report incidents direct to Cosmopolitan Housing Association and the Police.

## **What happens if I report an incident of domestic violence to Cosmopolitan Housing Association?**

We will provide you with advice and assistance. You do not need to provide proof of domestic violence. We can also offer you an interview with a person of the same sex or cultural background if you wish.

## **What will happen at the Cosmopolitan Housing Association Office?**

You will have a private interview within one working day of making a report to us. Wherever possible a person of the same sex and cultural background will talk to you, if that is what you need. Interviews will be carried out in a sympathetic and supportive manner and will be totally confidential, but the interviewer may have to contact other agencies such as the police or legal advisors with your permission. We will discuss what you should do about the situation in both the short and long term.

## **Will you tell anyone else about the incidents I have told you about?**

We will respect your confidence at all times and will not divulge your details to any other agencies without your consent.

## **Do I have to prove physical violence?**

We will investigate fairly any claims of domestic violence and will not insist that you provide proof of evidence.

## **What if I am a victim and I need help with housing?**

We will take all reports of domestic violence very seriously and will work with other agencies to try and resolve the issues to your satisfaction. This may include looking at emergency short-term and long-term housing options.




## **If I chose to stay in my home, what will you do to help protect me?**

We will consider evicting the alleged perpetrator from the property so you can return. If you stay in or return to your home there are a number of services that we can offer to help you remain in your home free from domestic violence. These include:

- Ongoing support
- Putting you in touch with a domestic violence agency
- Financial advice to help you maintain your home
- Additional security measures such as a spy hole, extra or new locks, door chains, a personal attack alarm, a mobile phone and extra security lighting.
- Assistance with an application for an Occupation Order under the Family Law act 1996
- If you are a joint tenant we will assist you with an application to transfer the tenancy to your sole name under the Family Law Act 1996
- Assist and support you to obtain an injunction against the person causing the domestic violence, which prevents them from living in the property and/or being in the immediate area of the property.





## **If I decide to allow you to take action against the person causing the domestic violence, what support will you give me as a witness?**

We will support you through this difficult time. With your agreement we will provide you with a support package that includes putting you in touch with a domestic violence agency, providing extra security measures such as extra locks, mobile phone, personal attack alarm and security lighting and where necessary CCTV cameras.

We will arrange transport to and from court if you so wish and could assist with childcare and other costs including loss of earnings for the hearing and expenses.

## **What if I decide to stay with the person who has caused the domestic violence?**

Although our main concern is for the victim of domestic violence, we recognise that in some cases you may want to remain in the relationship with the person who has caused the domestic violence, and respect your decision. In these instances, we may be able to refer you to agencies that are able to work with you and the person who caused the domestic violence.

The purpose of offering support to the person who caused the domestic violence is to assist them in trying to control and moderate their behaviour, by sign-posting them to support agencies.
